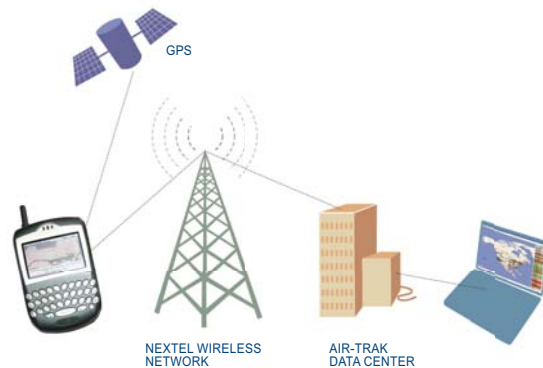

With Air-Trak service running on Nextel BlackBerry wireless handheld devices, dispatchers and managers can easily locate and track mobile employees in real time. You can access real time and historical information on employee locations to manage your mobile enterprise more effectively.

Powerful administrative capabilities for managers

With its simple but sophisticated design, Air-Trak gives managers unmatched flexibility for monitoring and managing the mobile workforce. You can remotely and independently configure each Nextel Blackberry device for a

variety of reporting options. You can set the frequency of position data reporting or opt to send position reports only after a velocity threshold is exceeded, or a given number of heading changes, or a given loitering period.

Using the Air-Trak Mobile Assist Display (a PDA-optimized version of the Air-Trak Web Display), a manager on the road can use a Nextel BlackBerry or other web-enabled PDA to access fleet status, locate units, and monitor unit activity. Location information includes street address and maps with 11 zoom levels.

Easy operation for mobile workers

Air-Trak launches automatically at Nextel BlackBerry power-up with no user configuration required.

With Air-Trak running on Nextel BlackBerry devices, you can:

> Ensure consistent tracking.

Air-Trak is automatically launched at Nextel BlackBerry power-up. In areas with no cellular coverage, location data is stored and forwarded when coverage resumes.

> Track and be tracked from a single PDA.

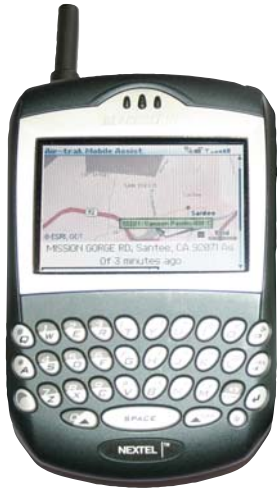
Track mobile workers who are using Nextel BlackBerry devices or manage the fleet from your own Nextel BlackBerry through the Air-Trak Mobile Assist Display.

> Communicate more efficiently.

Air-Trak enables dispatch to send pop-up messages to mobile workers.

Nextel BlackBerry devices transmit location and other data through the Nextel guaranteed wireless network to the Air-Trak Data Center, which is accessed by managers with an Internet-connected PC, web-enabled phone, or Nextel BlackBerry.

Getting started

Air-Trak Java-based software for Nextel BlackBerry wireless handheld devices can be downloaded and installed wirelessly, with automatic activation. Air-Trak service can be initiated without a long-term contract, with low monthly subscription fees.

The Air-Trak system

Air-Trak service can be deployed on any combination of supported Nextel GPS, Java-enabled phones from Sprint, Nextel BlackBerry wireless handheld devices or Air-Trak in-vehicle platforms. With the addition of the Air-Trak SatCom Upgrade, phone and in-vehicle platforms can cost effectively provide 100 percent satellite coverage where cellular coverage is unavailable.

All Air-Trak systems are compatible with each other, easily upgraded, fully scalable (up to thousands of units), and conveniently monitored and managed through the Air-Trak Web Display or Enterprise Display application.
